Holtom, Daniel and Elizabeth Fisher. *Enjoy Writing Your Science Thesis or Dissertation: A Step by Step Guide to Planning and Writing Dissertations and Theses for Undergraduate and Graduate Science Students*. Holtom and Fisher provide a user friendly book which can be read straight through or used as a reference tool. The book covers practical information on planning, organizing, writing, and presenting a science thesis or dissertation. Formatting and citations are also covered thoroughly.

Ogden, Evelyn Hunt. *Complete Your Dissertation or Thesis in Two Semesters or Less*. Encouraging students to complete the graduation process in a timely manner, the author focuses on how to "effectively and efficiently" complete a dissertation or thesis.
