Saint Louis University and YouGov surveyed 950 likely Missouri voters from July 19 { July 29 about current political issues, the COVID-19 pandemic, and education policy in Missouri. The following pages present results for most survey questions. The margin of error for survey results for the full sample is 4.18%. 

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


Do you approve or disapprove of the way each is doing their job...Joe Biden?


Do you approve or disapprove of the way each is doing their job...The US Congress?








Do you approve or disapprove of the way each is doing their job...Senator Roy Blunt?




Do you approve or disapprove of the way each is doing their job...Senator Josh Hawley?














